## ACTIVE IN HANDLING COVID-19, LIPPO CIKARANG GETS NUSANTARA CSR AWARDS 2020

Jakarta, October 22, 2020 – The emergence of Covid-19 in Indonesia has been announced by the Central Government since March 2020, the first case was found by two residents living in Depok, West Java. Two positive Covid-19 patients in Indonesia started when one of them had close contact with a Japanese citizen who turned out to be positive for Covid-19.

The Cumulative Number of COVID-19 Cases to 20/10 in Indonesia Has Now Reached 365,240 Cases. Of these, 293,653 patients were declared cured. Then 12,734 people were reported dead.

Covid-19 cases are also found in many industrial clusters, one of the largest is in Bekasi Regency. From the latest data, the total number of Covid-19 cases to 20/10 was 3,804 people, 2,600 of them from industrial clusters.

Related to this case, there is a need for synergy between the government and the private sector to jointly reduce the number of spread of the Covid-19 virus in the community. Various efforts will be made to reduce the spread of Covid-19 cases.

Lippo Cikarang, as an urban and industrial developer, also contributed to handling Covid-19. Efforts have been made since March 2020 by spraying disinfectants throughout the clusters in Lippo Cikarang gradually, as well as public facilities and social facilities in it.

Not only that, Lippo Cikarang also distributed masks for residents who had difficulty getting masks during the mask crisis at the start of the pandemic, providing rice assistance for residents affected by the economy in the midst of the pandemic.

Handling must be done quickly and on target so as to reduce the number of spread of Covid-19 in the Lippo Cikarang area, even Bekasi Regency. For the contribution that has been made, Lippo Cikarang received an award through the Health and Economic Assistance category for Covid-19 Emergency Management which was held by the Nusantara CSR Awards 2020 at the Kempinski Hotel, Jakarta.
