The strategic location is located in the East Jakarta Corridor, which can be accessed through 2 toll gates, namely the Cibatu KM 34 + 700 toll and the Cikarang Barat KM 31 toll road, and can be accessed through an industrial zone that runs from the west to the east of the East Jakarta Corridor, namely MM2100. , EJIP, Jababeka, Delta Silicon, Hyundai, and GIIC, making access to and from the Waterfront Estates very strategic and easy to reach.
